The Marketplace Movement... 7 Mountains... YWAM = NAR-connected

Dear friends in Christ Jesus,

In the end of 2012 I came in touch with a woman from Norway via Caryl Matrisciana... <http://caryl.tv.com/>
We found each other quickly and felt "the unity of the Spirit" – understood each other exactly regarding heresies etc.
She sent me a document that her daughter had written to the YWAM-base Grimerud in Norway. She had written about her experience with Restore 24/7 - YWAM - Youth With A Mission – to point out the unbiblical doctrines that they have taken into their teachings.

I have read this document several times, and feel strongly that this needs to be spread to **"warn those who want to be warned"**! Much of what she brings up is "confirming" what I have mentioned in previous newsletters – especially about NAR = New Apostolic Reformation...

In my previous newsletter "Todd Bentely = NARian" >> (page 22-25) I mentioned about Rick Pino – worship leader within NAR – whom she also mentions about in her document.

That Loren Cunningham, the founder of YWAM, is behind the "7 Mountains Strategy" has also been mentioned in previous newsletters "7 Mountains... K.E.Y.S. = NAR" >> (page 3)

I believe that what she writes should be taken very seriously!

Quote from her document:

Regarding "New Apostolic Reformation", it is a big topic which I don't have the opportunity to go into details on here. But I can see that a lot of what we were taught at Restore 24/7 was influenced by this movement, especially regarding revival. That a big "revival" is on the way, and a "pouring of the Spirit", like a "fire". There are a lot of big words and seemingly little real distress for God to send his Spirit of Truth which convicts about sin, righteousness and judgment, which leads to turning onto the Lord, preaching of His Word and salvation for the people.

Also it is unbelievable how these "Christian leaders", most of them from the USA, have gained so much influence in Norway. They are invited to conferences and their books are translated into Norwegian. If one does a little research one will find many warnings, especially from American and English believers who have studied this movement and the spirit it is communicating. See the resources at the end of the document for further study.

International House Of Prayer

I have studied different information about the teaching from "International House Of Prayer", see the resources at the bottom of the document. If I would have had this information in advance, I would never have joined Restore 24/7. Like mentioned earlier I reacted to the teaching from IHOP already in the fall of 2011. One of the leaders communicated that "Restore 24/7 is not IHOP, but we use some of their ideas". Looking back I realize that almost everything was taken from IHOP. Most of the leaders had been there, "prayer-missionaries" came from there and their methods, teaching and "live stream" were used. Utterances from Mike Bickle or other IHOP leaders were often cited. The terminology and teaching from IHOP permeated Restore 24/7. It was for example talked about "forerunners" (like John and Elijah, who are to prepare for Jesus' return) and the "bridal paradigm".

Irene A. from Norway has given me permission to share this document in my newsletter.

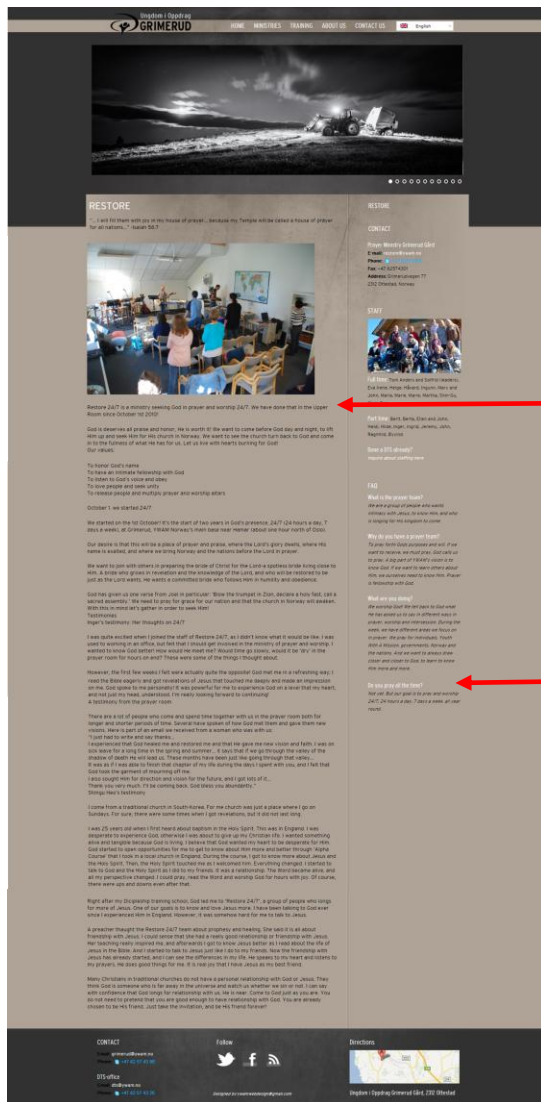
Irene wrote:

It has been very good to get in touch with you, and to have someone to stand together with who understands something about what I have been going through. I didn't want to publish this document on my own, since it was intended for the people who were in Restore. In one way it is better that someone else is publishing it, and then it is not me that is "promoting my own cause". It is quite a personal experience, and people can probably twist the story into their own meaning as well. In one of the messages I got from the main leader in YWAM Norway, he said that some of the sources were not correct. I asked him if he could point out anything specific, but he never replied on that. I believe I have been selective in choosing the sources; I wanted to make sure that they were factual, to the point and

serious. If you or any other should find something that is wrong or not Biblical, I would like to hear about it. Perhaps you can mention that when you publish it?

I really think Irene used the gift of discernment and boldly dared to explain how it really was when she was there!! If the sources were not correct... and the leader has not responded and provided with the right sources, I guess he just tried to stop her... I have read the document several times and cannot remember anything that I would have thought to be unbiblical on her part. **On the contrary, what she has uncovered is unbiblical teachings taking place at YWAM in Grimerud Norway and by doing so (= exposing it!), She was VERY BIBLICAL!**

Irene also wanted me to point out that what she has written was from her experience during the time she was there from August 2011 to June 2012... a lot may have changed since then... some links in the document may also have been removed...



But what I saw on their website it seems that **they still want 24/7 prayers**, so I feel that her information is **still accurate and up to date!**

Over 30K People Gather in Kansas City for Prayer Conference

Leaders from key movements in missions, evangelism, prayer and Bible translation met together for the first time to strategize. Here's what happened in that historic meeting.

More than 30,000 people from 100 countries gathered in Kansas City for the Onething Conference hosted by the International House of Prayer (IHOPKC) in late December.

The conference was also the launch of what is to be an annual summit of the major leaders in the missions, prayer and Bible translation movements and a partnership with the Seed Company of Wycliffe Bible Translators.

"We want to see the gospel preached and **24/7 worship and prayer** in every tribe and tongue," said **Mike Bickle**, founder of IHOPKC, in the opening session.

- Mark Anderson, **a leader with Youth With a Mission**, calls the summit historic.

"We are in a time right now where **we are launching a new expression of missions and prayer**," he says.

**This "confirms" YWAM's involvement with Mike Bickle/IHOP and their 24/7 prayer movement!
Exactly what Irene has written about in her document...**

This of course concerns YWAM around the world – including Sweden, sadly!

Youth With A Mission is an international volunteer movement **of Christians from many backgrounds, cultures and Christian traditions (= Ecumenical!)**, dedicated to serving Jesus throughout the world. This text below does not appear on the English version... hmm... one can wonder why?! (pardon my SwEnglish translation!)

Youth With A Mission's core values express our fundamental beliefs, but **also the rules God gave at YWAM's establishment 1960 (= the NARian Loren Cunningham is YWAM's founder).**

They are written down so that the voice of God addressed to YWAM will be passed on to future generations.

These values and belief systems **have been and will be the guiding principles of YWAM's growth.** Some of them are common to all Christians everywhere, **others are distinctive to Youth With A Mission. The combination of belief systems and values give YWAM its unique family traits – our "DNA".** We esteem these values, which show who we are, how we live and how we make decisions.

5. To be visionary

YWAM is called to be visionary by **constantly receive, develop, and redeem new visions from God.** We support the start-up of new work and methods and **want to be radical** in order to reach all generations, ethnic groups and sections of society. We believe that **YWAM's apostolic call** requires interaction between mature spiritual leadership, freedom in the Spirit and freedom in relationships, all based on the word of God.

7. Have a broad structure and be decentralized

YWAM is a diverse organization with a broad structure, but simultaneously integrated. We are **a global family** of various jobs that are **kept together by a shared vision, values, goals and relationships**. We believe the structures are there to serve the people and God's purposes. All work at all levels has therefore the responsibility and privilege to be **accountable to a group of elders, and even to the YWAM Global Leadership Team, GLT**.

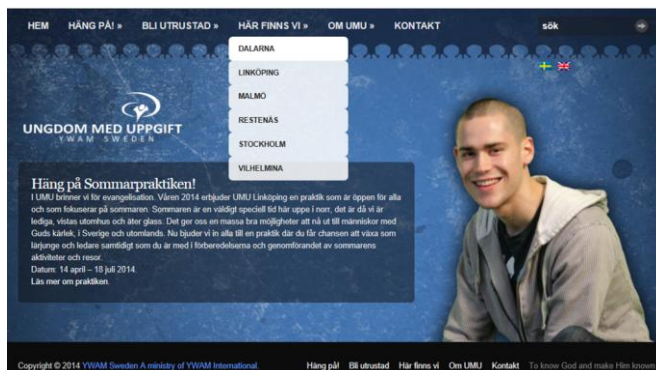

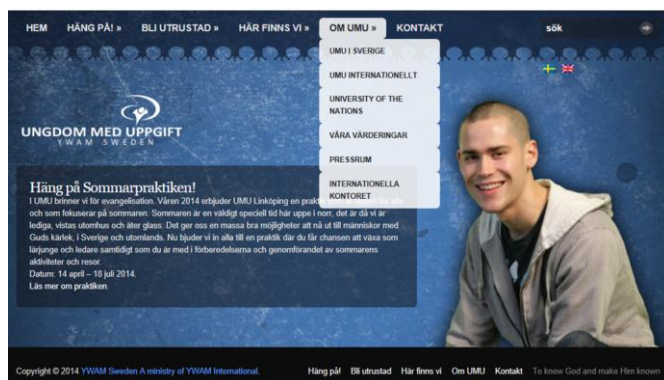

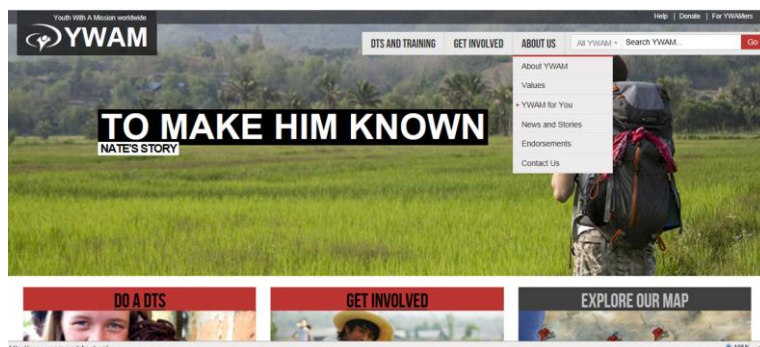

14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.

15 Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works. (King James Version)

Jeremiah 23:1, 16-17, 22, 31-32, 36

1 Woe be unto the pastors that destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture! saith the Lord.

16 Thus saith the Lord of hosts, Hearken not unto the words of the prophets that prophesy unto you: they make you vain: they speak a vision of their own heart, and not out of the mouth of the Lord.

17 They say still unto them that despise me, The Lord hath said, Ye shall have peace; and they say unto every one that walketh after the imagination of his own heart, No evil shall come upon you.

22 But if they had stood in my counsel, and had caused my people to hear my words, then they should have turned them from their evil way, and from the evil of their doings.

31 Behold, I am against the prophets, saith the Lord, that use their tongues, and say, He saith.

32 Behold, I am against them that prophesy false dreams, saith the Lord, and do tell them, and cause my people to err by their lies, and by their lightness; yet I sent them not, nor commanded them: therefore they shall not profit this people at all, saith the Lord.

36 And the burden of the Lord shall ye mention no more: for every man's word shall be his burden; for ye have perverted the words of the living God, of the Lord of hosts our God. (King James Version)

Let's not follow man – self-appointed apostles and prophets – with their methods, strategies, visions and plans. Instead, let us read the Bible and only follow what is written therein and **trust God's Holy Spirit to lead us right!**

Johannes 16:7-15

7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away:

for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.

8 And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

9 Of sin, because they believe not on me;

10 Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more;

11 Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged.

12 I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now.

13 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.

14 He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you.

15 All things that the Father hath are mine: therefore said I, that he shall take of mine, and shall shew it unto you.

(King James Version)
